# Snoball

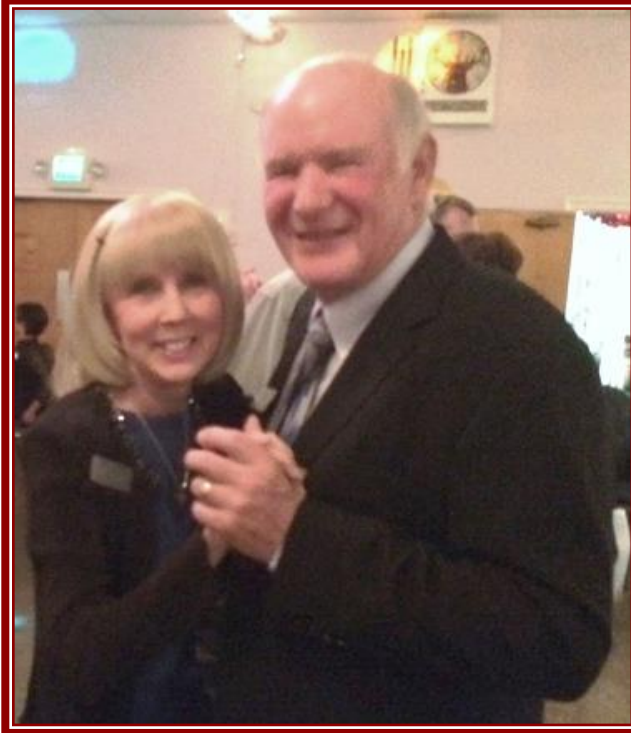
